The 2007-2008 school year has been the first year of implementation of the MA Model for Comprehensive School Counseling Programs at seven Agawam Public Schools. We have collected baseline data and over time, we will be measuring progress at a district level as well as at each school within the district.

## Focus for Improvement

Our long term plan is to create the type of programming needed based on the outcome data which will be reflected in these charts each year, as we continue to implement the MA Model at each of the seven schools in the district. During the second year of implementation, our immediate goals are to improve attendance throughout the district and reduce the dropout rate at the high school.

Classroom lesson outcome data and Support Group outcome data are being captured and will be assessed to identify how students are different as a result of our school counseling program.
